



REACH – General Conformity Declaration

Dear customer,

We process polymers by injection moulding, do, however, neither produce nor import any chemicals. Besides that we sell plastic parts and multicomponent plastic composites (metal, felt etc.). So our enterprise is a downstream user in the sense of the REACH Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization of Chemicals), complemented by Regulation (EU) No. 1272/2013 dated 06/12/2013.

Our obligations are settled there in title VI, articles 31 to 36 (“Information in the supply chain”) and in title V, articles 37 to 39 (“Downstream users”). We confirm that we are fully aware of these obligations and by law obliged to conform with the REACH regulations.

We have our polymer suppliers’ confirmations that they (pre-)register all relevant substances and inform us in case they supply any substances (SVHC – substances of very high concern) of the todote candidate list with substances being evaluated as dangerous.

According to our present state of knowledge, there are no restrictions to be expected for the substances we make use of by the current SVHC list state 27/06/2018.

The plastic parts we produce do not have to be registered as such.
