



California Proposition 65

Dear customer,

California Proposition 65 (CA Prop 65) is a law enacted in 1986 in the US state of California, that was intended to promote the cleanliness of drinking water.

It says in substance that no person shall, in the course of his or her business, whether knowingly or unknowingly expose other people to a chemical which, according to the current state of knowledge, can cause cancer or cause birth defects in newborn babies without informing consumers clearly, conspicuously and in an appropriate context about this risk.

CA Prop 65 affects all businesses, that market products in California. We are not directly active in this market. The State of California has, among other things, published a list of chemicals suspected of being carcinogenic or toxic to reproduction. The list currently contains more than 1,000 substances.

Our products may contain listed substances. The sale and use of the listed substances or products containing these substances is not prohibited by California Proposition 65.

We would like to point out that you, as a marketer of our products in California, may be subject to further obligations as a result of their use.
