



REACH – Absence of SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern)

Dear customer,

In accordance with Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, we comply with the obligation to provide information along the supply chain for SVHC substances without having to be separately requested to do so.

As a rule, this obligation to provide information applies to the products we supply as soon as the concentration of the respective substance in the product exceeds 0.1 percent by mass. It applies to most articles, e.g. household goods, textiles, shoes, sporting goods, furniture, DIY supplies, electrical/electronic appliances, toys, vehicles or packaging.

Since 23/01/2024 [ECHA](#) lists 240 SVHC substances.

SCIP is the database for information on **S**ubstances of **C**oncern **I**n articles as such or in complex objects (**P**roducts) established under the Waste Framework Directive (WFD).

Since 05/01/2021, the obligation to transmit a SCIP message applies to all products that are sold on the EU market and contain a substance of very high concern on the Candidate List in a concentration of more than 0.1 % by mass.

Such products are currently not offered or sold by us. Therefore we have no obligation to submit a SCIP notification to ECHA.

If you do not receive any notification from us to the contrary, you can assume that no SVHC substances above the limit value will be used.
