The chemicals

lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB's), polybrominated diphenyl esters (PBDE's), pentaBDE, octaBDE, decaBDE, perfluorooctansulphonate (PFOS), bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), benzyl butylphthalate (BBP), dibutylphthalate (DBP), diisobutylphthalate (DIBP)

mentioned in directives 2002/95/EG, 2011/65/EU, 2015/863 and 2000/53/EG quoted are neither added to our products by us nor by our suppliers for raw materials and colours while processing.

The galvanization of all threaded parts such as inserts and adjusters and the steel reinforcements for plug in connectors do not contain any hexavalent chromium.

Substances to be declared according to Global Automotive Declarable Substance list (GADSL) are not added to our products while processing.

So we do not expect to find these chemicals in our products.

As the directive **2002/96/EG** refers to used electric and electronic devices, we think it is not relevant for our products.
